

# GPEX Appeals Policy

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## Note

This policy commences on 1 January 2016 and will apply to all registrars in the GPEX training program under the Australian General Practice Training (AGPT) Program.

### 1. Purpose

This policy sets out the circumstances under which a registrar may appeal a decision of the Grievance Management Committee (GMC) made in accordance with the GPEX Registrar Grievance Policy.

### 2. Scope of this policy

This policy applies to registrars enrolled in the GPEX training program.

### 3. Policy statement

- 3.1 A registrar may only appeal to their Relevant College in accordance with the *AGPT Program Appeals Policy 2020* after exhausting options under the *GPEX Registrar Grievance Policy*.
- 3.2 Only decisions made by the GMC can be reviewed under the *AGPT Program Appeals Policy 2020*.
- 3.3 GPEX will co-operate with any appeal process or request for further information when requested by the Relevant College in accordance with the *AGPT Program Appeals Policy 2020*.
