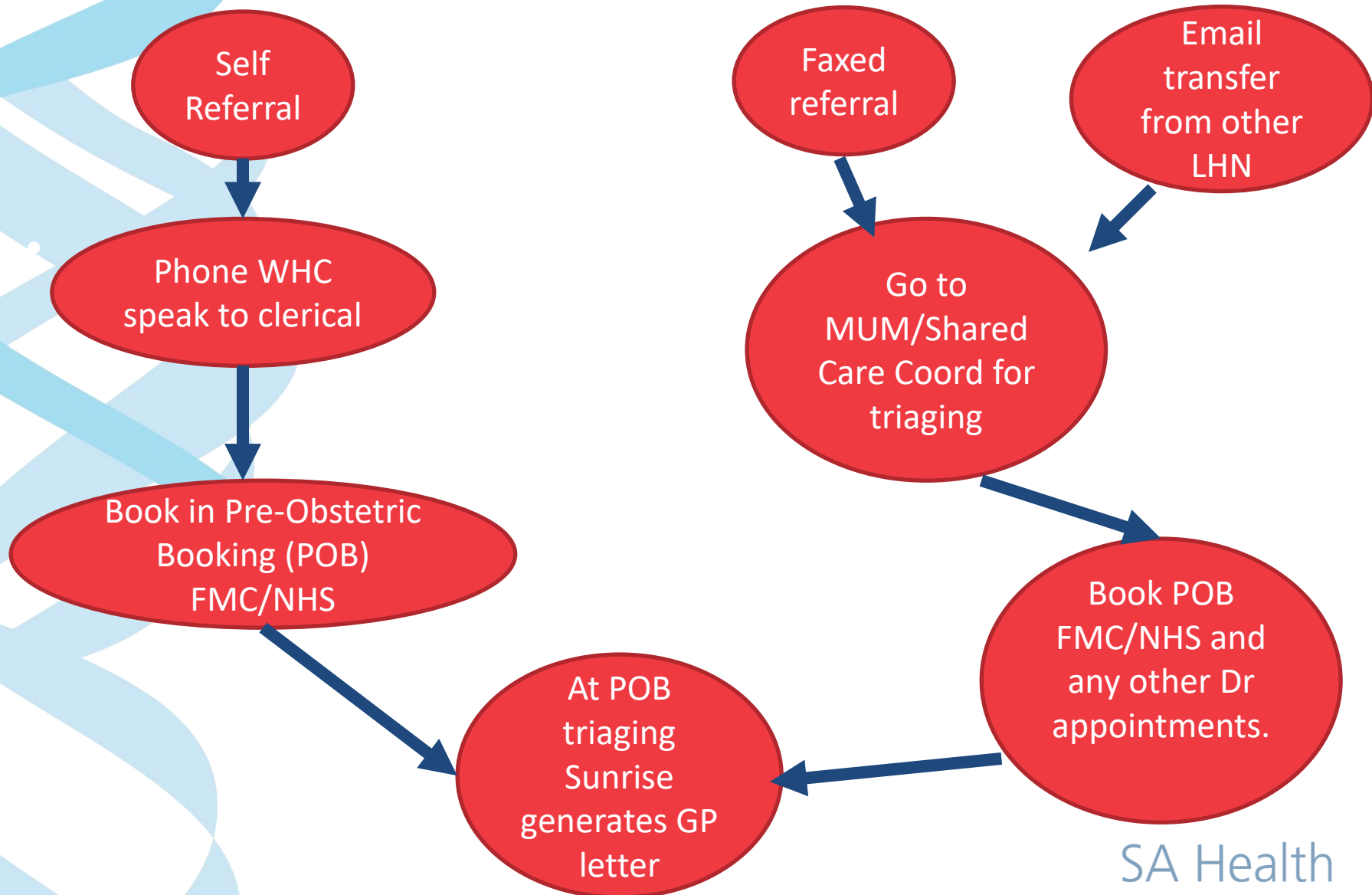
# Duties of Obstetric Shared Care Co-ordinator

- > Currently the role of the Shared Care Coordinator sits under the Midwifery Unit Manager of AWHS:
- > 2 days per week otherwise MUM
  - Antenatal, Gynaecology, GynaeOncology, Colposcopy, Urodynamics, clinics across 3 sites
  - Antenatal Education
  - Termination Services
  - Maternity Outreach
  - Shared Care Co-Ordinator
- > Liaise with GP about abnormal results.
- > Book women before 20 weeks and again at 36 & 40 weeks.
- > Arrange anti-D to be sent out
- > Ensure professional standards and documentation is maintained.
- > Ensure GPs follow the minimal schedule of visits.
- > Monitor GPs adherence to protocols.
- > Raise corrective action forms to GP Partners.

# Models of care offered at first visit.

- > Low risk women
  - GP Shared Care, especially non-medicare women
  - SMGP
  - RMOs,
  - Midwife led Clinics
- > Moderate to high risk women
  - GPs,
  - Registrars
  - Consultants
  
- Self Referral
- Faxes
- eReferrals coming (Statewide initiative)
- Emails for transfers from other LHNs
- Privately Practising Midwives

# Referral Pathways



# First visit

- > Commence Hand Held record if GP hasn't already – Version 11
- > Check bloods and first trimester/harmony/NEST results
- > BP & MSSU
- > Calculate due date by first ultrasound
- > ANRQ & EPDS – new ANRQ & scoring sheet (iCOPE website has screening in other languages)
- > Check for early GTT screen if meets criteria.
- > Give form for 20wk morphology scan & cervical length
- > Refer if  $\wedge$ BMI, twins, cardiac, hyperthyroid etc as per maternity allocation tool.
- > Discuss models of care.
- > If GP S/C send letter to GP. Book 36 & 40 week visit.

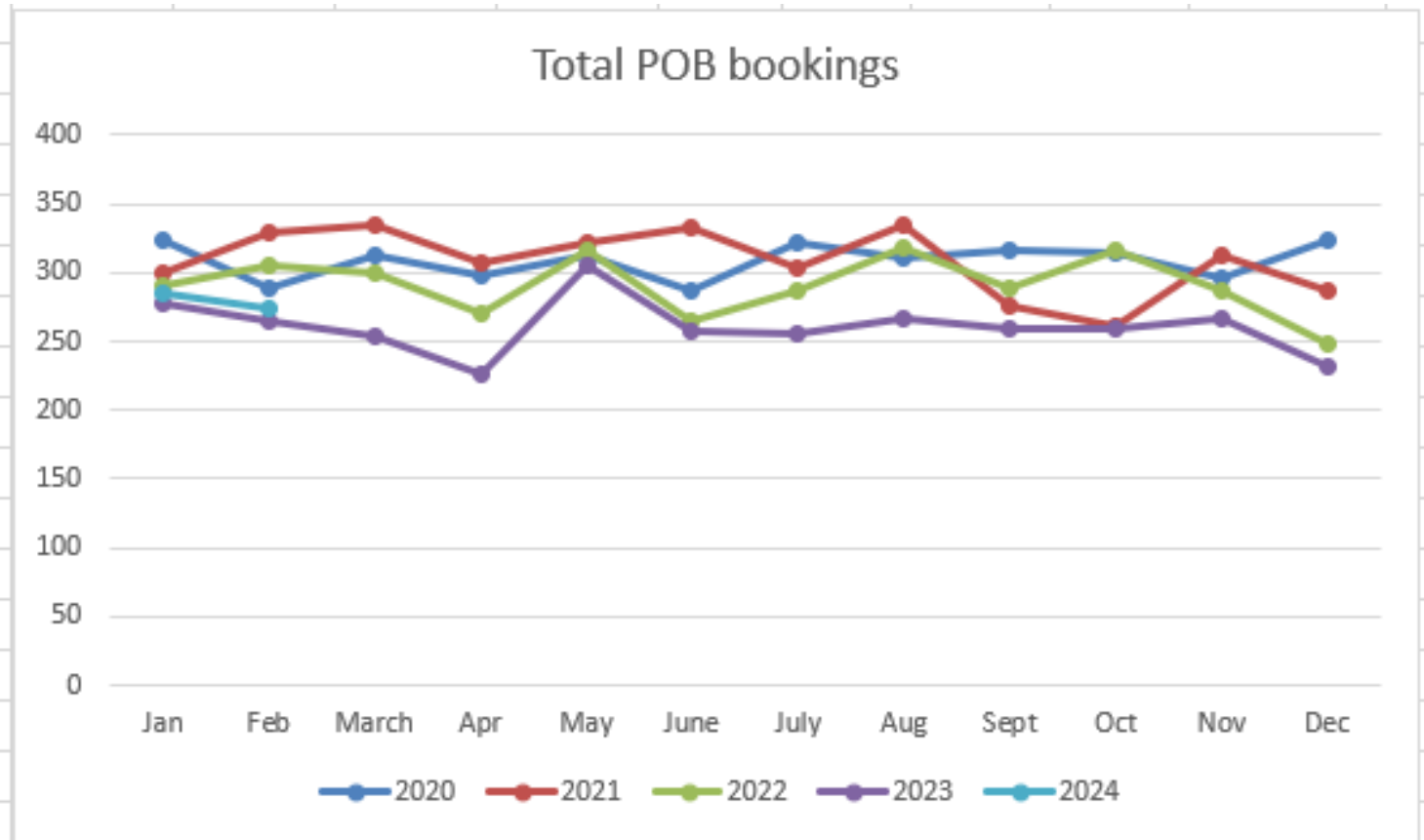
## Following first visit

- > Southern Links program (DASSA, PNMH, Social work..)
- > Obstetric Medicine
- > Perinatal mental health nurse
- > If GP S/C and negative blood group MUM sends record to transfusion who send out anti-D at 28/34 weeks once they have phoned the practice.
- > Monthly stats about bookings and births are sent to GP Partners.

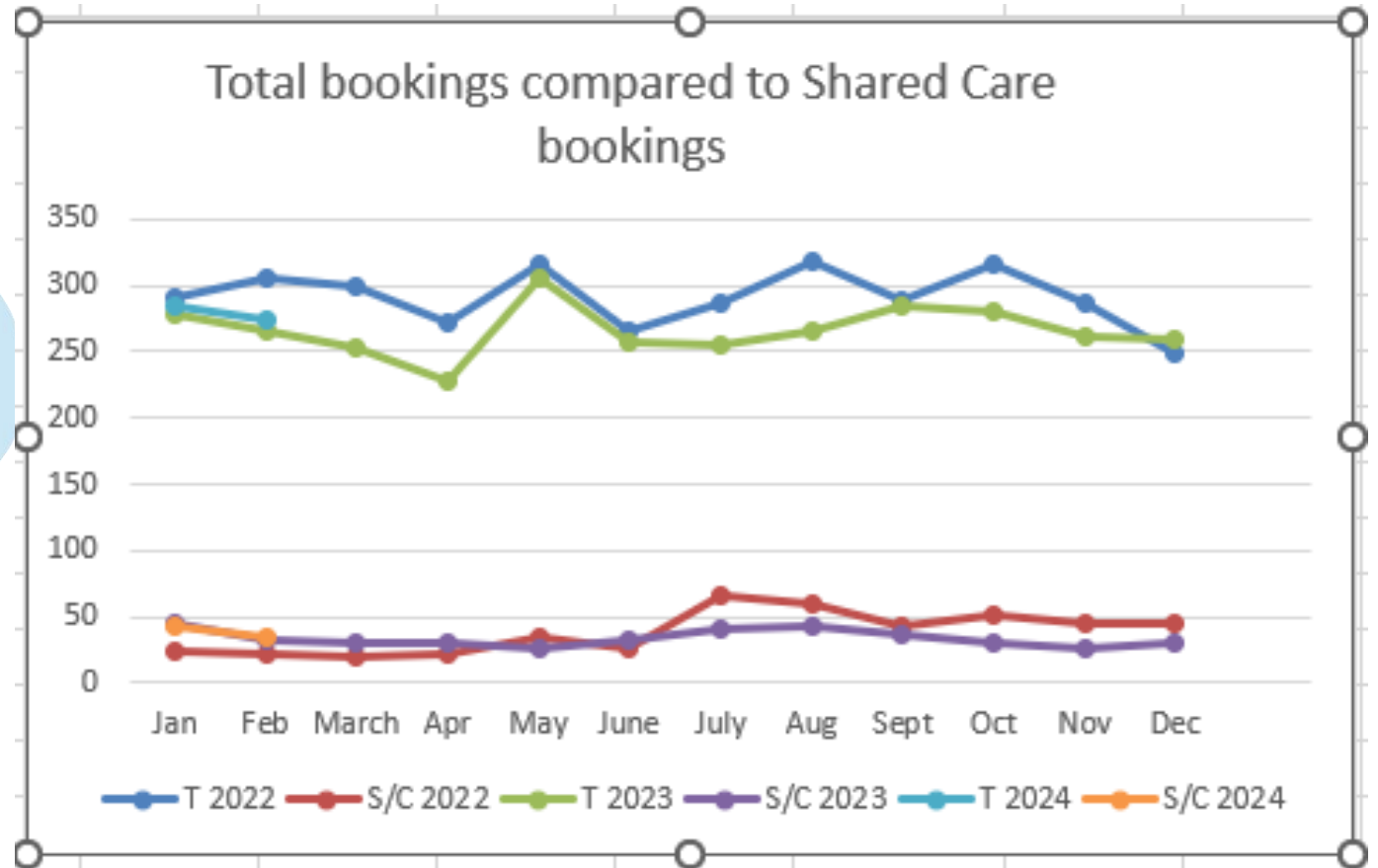
## Updates about other services

# Obstetric bookings total stats

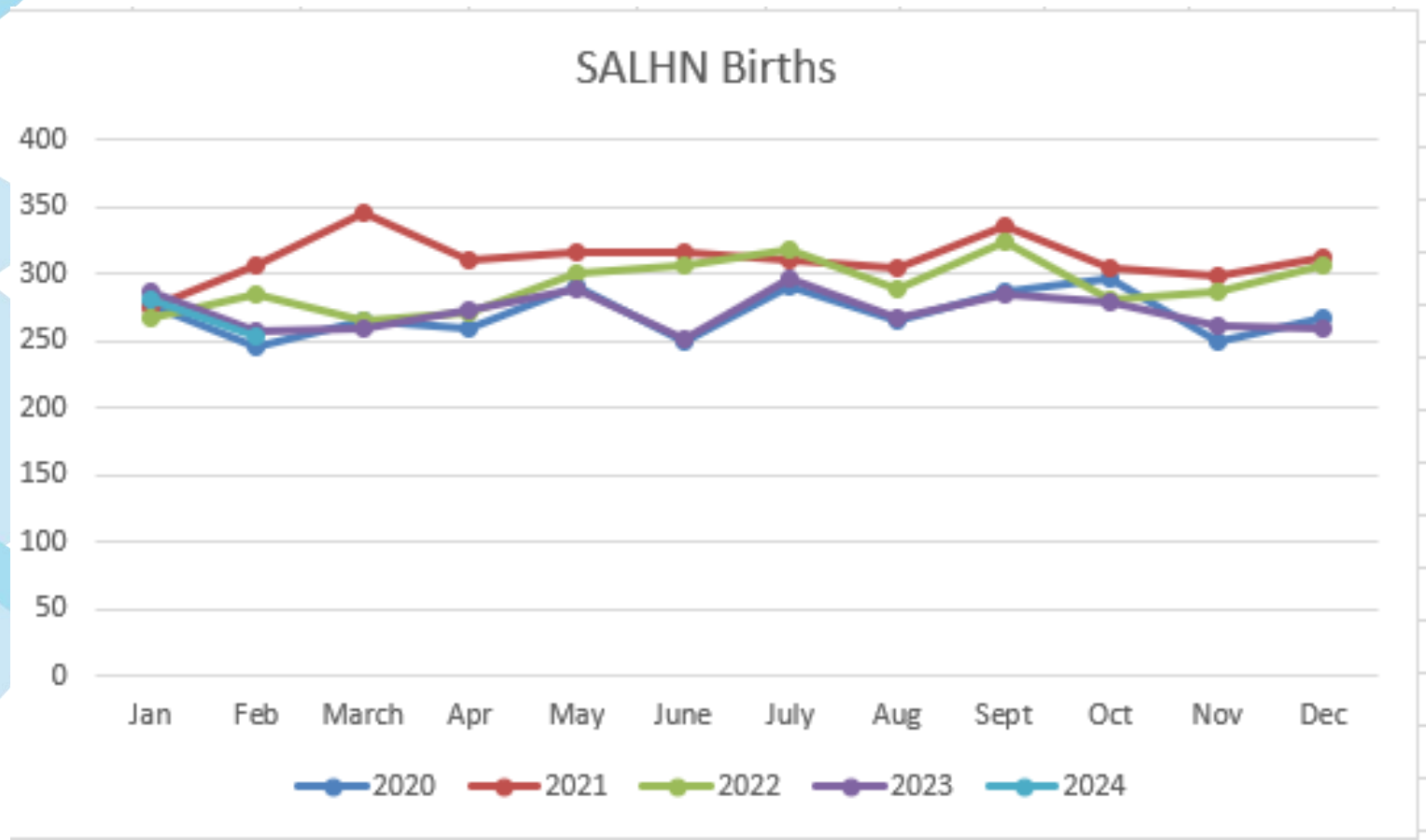


# Shared Care bookings
